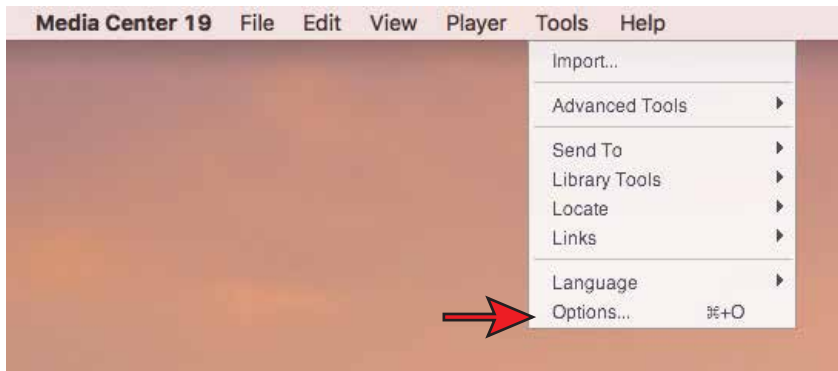
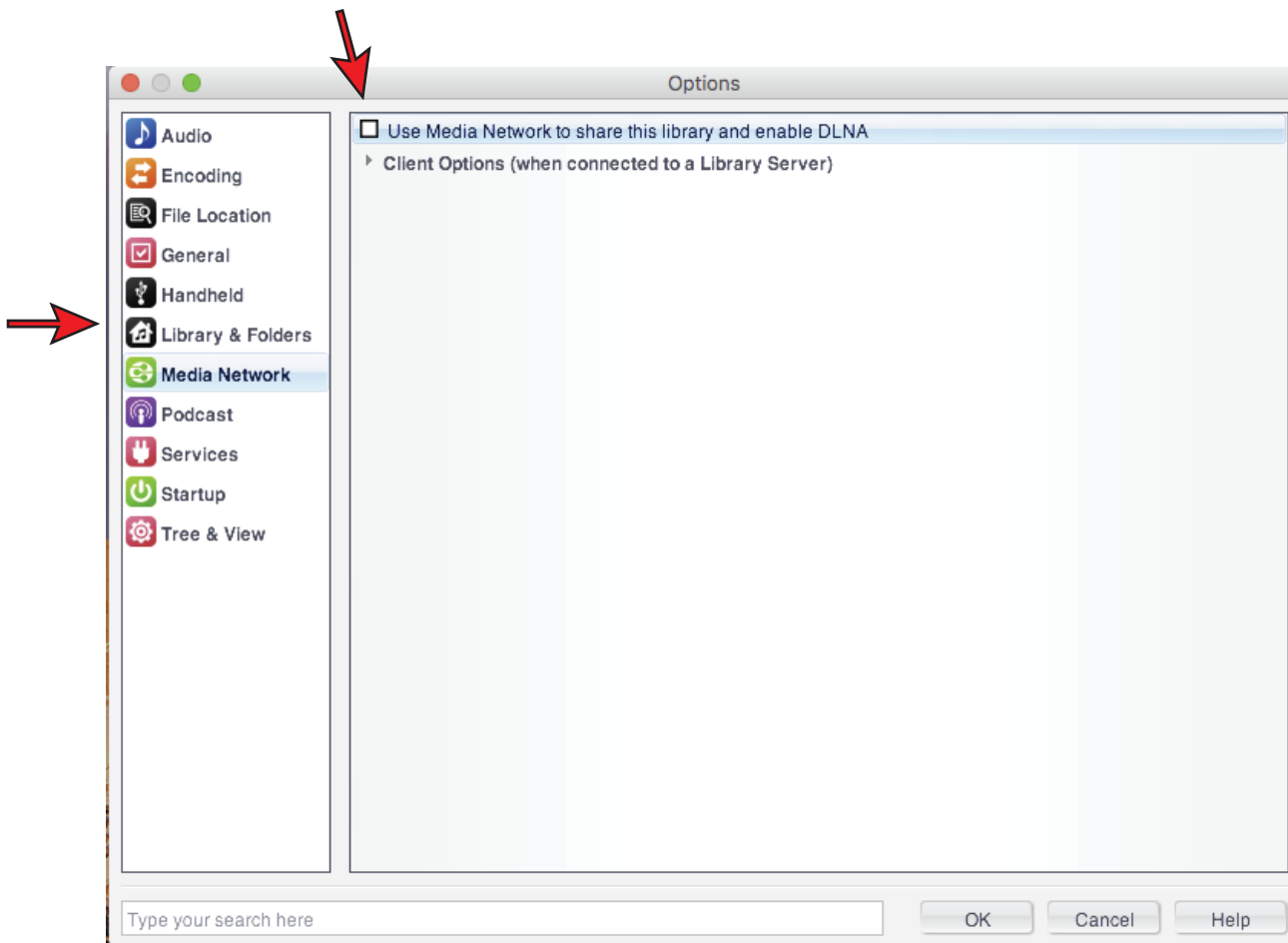


JRiver DLNA Configuration Mac / PC

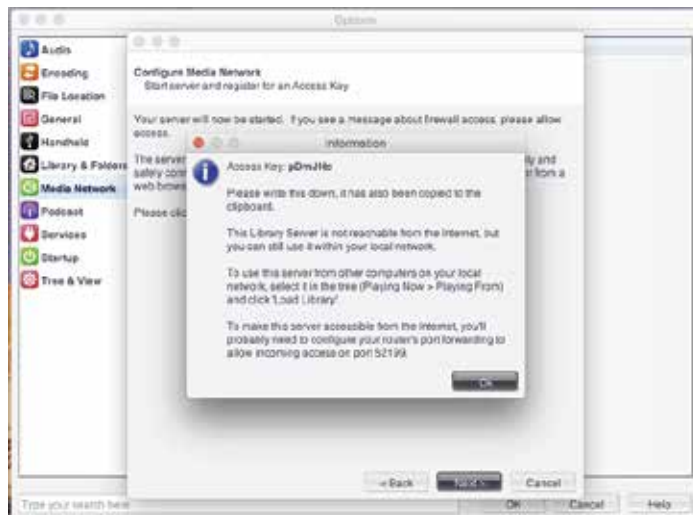
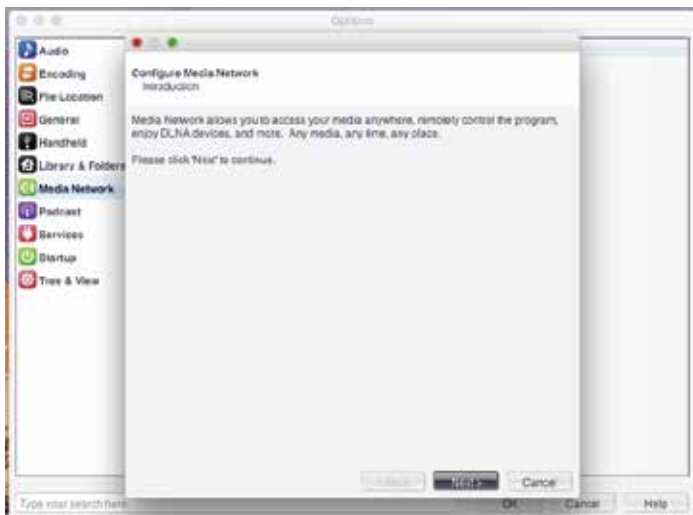
1. Launch JRiver Media Center and navigate from the top menu to "Tools -> Options"



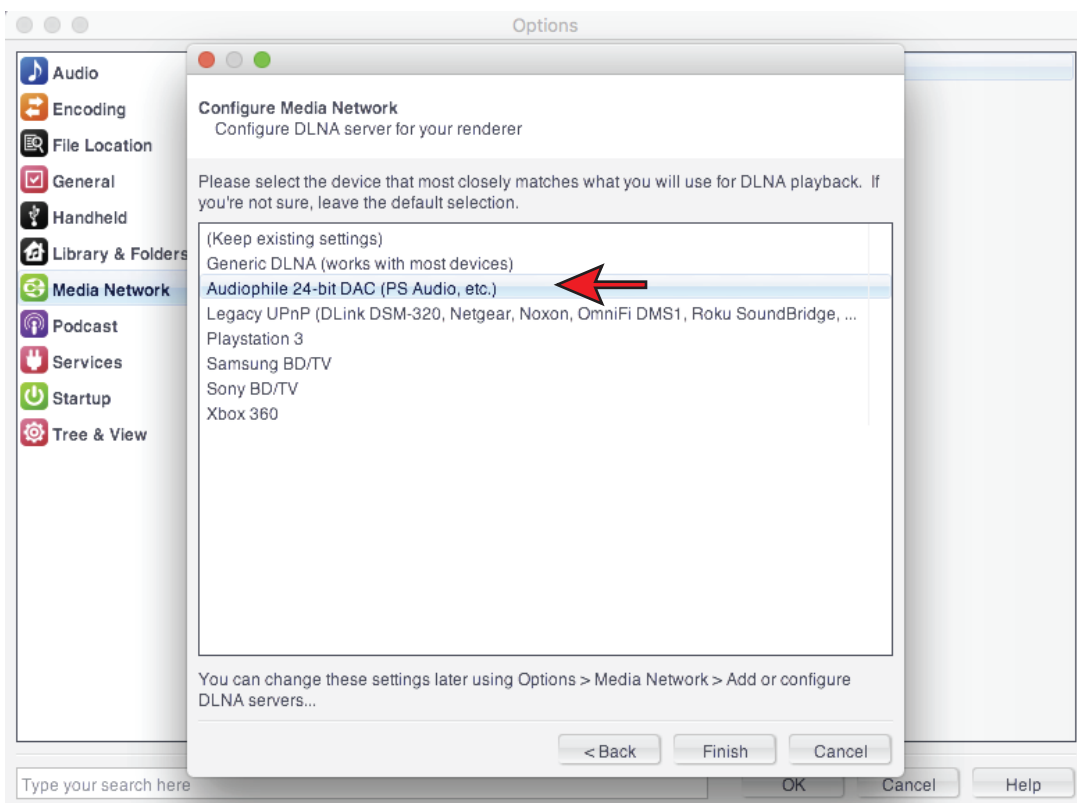
2. In the options pane select "Network Media." Select the box "Use Media Network to share this library and enable DLNA."



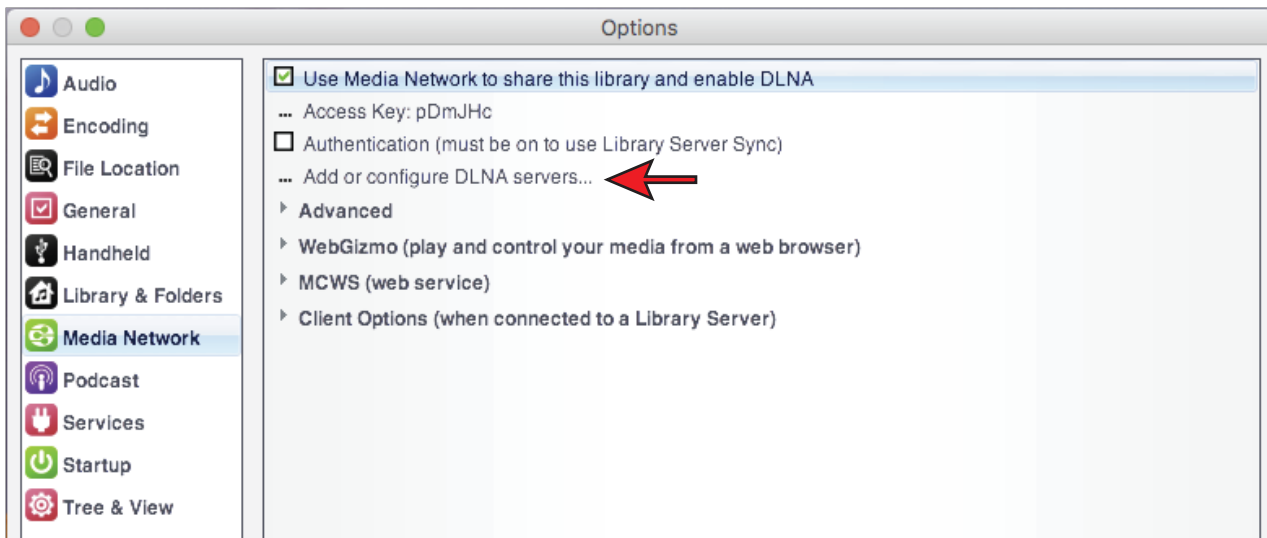
3. You will be prompted through 3 windows to complete this process. The second window will offer you an access key that you can use to setup the JRemote app for IOS offered in the Apple app store or the free Bubble App for Android users offered through the JRiver website.



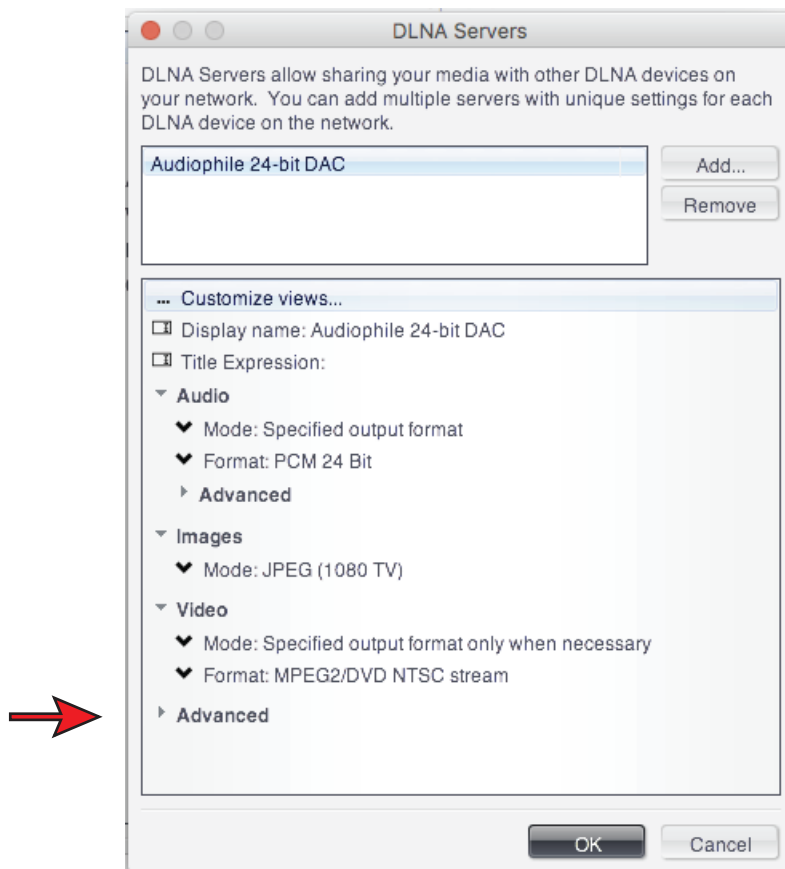
In the third window select "Audiophile 24-bit DAC. Now click "Finish" and you will be back at the options window.



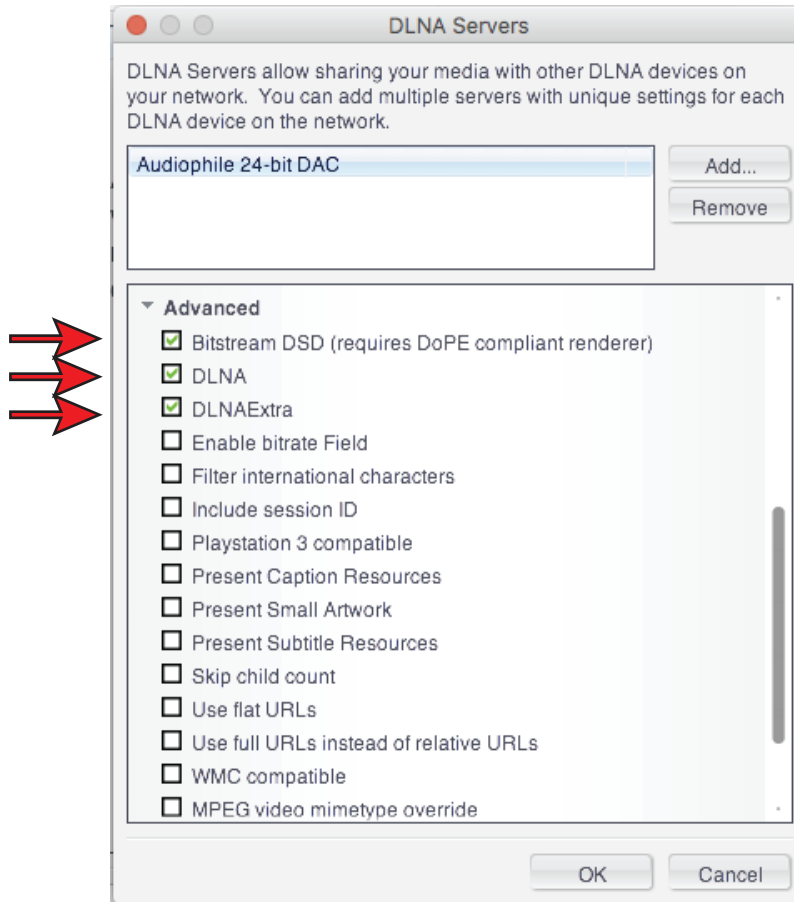
4. Select Add or configure DLNA servers



At the bottom select "Advanced."



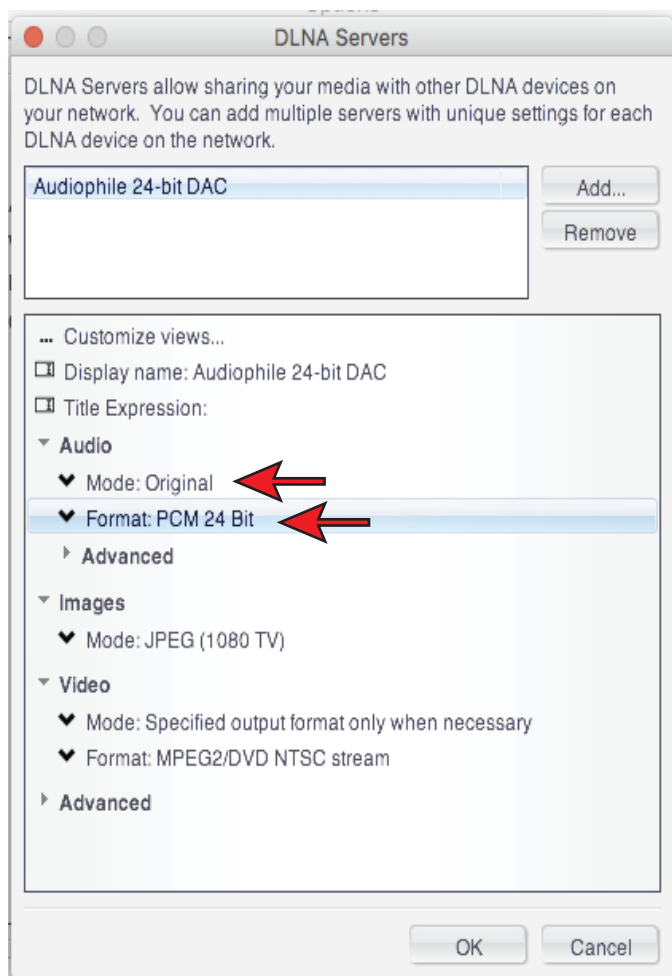
Ensure that the first three boxes have been select and click "OK."



Select "Add or configure DNLA Servers" from the Media Network option once again.



Here you will click on these 2 drop down menus and ensure they are selected to "Mode:Original" and "Format: PCM 24 Bit."When Completed click "OK" to close the DLNA Servers Menu and then click "OK" again to close the Options menu.



Now select the Network player as shown under "Playing Now" to enable the network player to the left on the main menu on the home screen. With the player selected you can now play audio to your network player. Your setup is now complete.
